RULES FOR CONDUCTING THE SHOW (ECAHO Rules Blue Book 2017 for Conduct of Shows will be applied in their entirety and will be available from our webpage www.scandinavianopen.se or from www.ECAHO.org

1. By participating at a show, show organizers, judges, exhibitors, owners and handlers agree that they will unconditionally submit themselves and the persons assisting and accompanying them to the "Rules for Conduct of Shows" and, as regards veterinary matters and drug misuse, to the relevant ECAHO Veterinary Regulations and ECAHO Rules for Medication Control. The accompanying persons include e.g. trainers or persons representing the show organizer as well as assistants of any of those persons. They will accept the jurisdiction of the Disciplinary Committee (DC), the Standing Disciplinary Committee (SDC) and the ECAHO Appeals Committee (EAC).

The person who has signed the entry form will be considered to be the person responsible for the horse in question. These Rules will be interpreted when necessary under the provisions of the laws of Switzerland.

2. Horses must be accompanied at the show by a horse passport containing all vaccination records. Those horses coming from a country that does not issue a passport, must be accompanied by an official Registration document which includes a graphic description and all vaccination records. If, when a horse attends a show, it's passport is at the Registry for any reason, then a letter from the registrar attesting to this must be provided along with a photo-copy of the passport, including the description and the vaccination records.

Date of Registration

The "Date of Registration" is defined as the date at which the relevant national registry declares that the horse has been accepted for registration. National Registries will be responsible for confirming the date of registration. Entries must either present the relevant registration certificate or enclose, with the entry form, a letter by the registrar confirming that registration will be completed before the first day of the show.

- **General Classes** Classes of the following categories are recognized by EAHSC:
- colts (junior males, 1-3 years old),
- fillies (junior females, 1-3 years old),
- stallions (senior males, 4 years+),
- mares (senior females, 4 years +),
- geldings (junior (1-3 years old) and senior (4 years+), or combined (1year+).

All classes -part from LIBERTY class - will be held outdoors on a sand arena.

SPECIFIC ORIGIN - ARAB HORSES .

STRAIGHT EGYPTIAN CHAMPIONSHIP - ECAHO qualifier. Open ONLY for Pure bred Straight Egyptian Arab registered in the Pyramid Society.. Not Egyptian related.

Judging system: Comparative System - One judge judging the horses by comparing and ranking them.

Conditions of Entry:

Open to horses registered in any WAHO recognized studbook by the closing date of entries, however, these shows are open only to horses of specific origin (Straight Egyptian)

Entry restrictions:

Title Show or A Show Champion Gold and Silver medal winners are not allowed to take part in a Specific Origin show for the rest of that calendar year and the two calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior, from junior to a senior category. Geldings that have won Champion Gold or Silver medals at a Title Show or an A show cannot be shown at S shows for the rest of that calendar year and one calendar year following.

Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of €600 and the horse will be disqualified.

The Classwinner in each Class will be regarded as the Champion of the categorie

First in each Class will receive a Cup and Champion Garland, first to sixth place wil receive a ribbon.

Comparison/Ranking Method of Judging

The steward will invite you into the ring at the start of the class. You may enter the ring either at walk or trot depending on the stewards instructions, listen carefully. You will enter on the right rein. If you enter at trot, trot all the way around the arena until you return to the entrance or catch up to the horse that entered the ring in front of you.

Wait patiently, with plenty of space between horses until instructed by the steward to walk on, once all the horses have entered the ring.

In the walk your horse should show a nice free balanced walk. You should allow plenty of room between yourself and other horses. When instructed by the Steward, the horses will be halted in one corner of the ring. When all the horses are halted, the steward, through direction from the judge will instruct each competitor in turn, to trot their horse around the arena to the back of the line.

The judge will instruct an initial line up of the horses; this will be done via the steward. The steward will call the horses into line. The first horse will be placed by the steward. The second horse will stand to the left of the first, the third to the left of the second, and so on down the line until all the horses are placed.

The steward will instruct competitors in turn, starting with the first placed horse, to step forward and stand in front of the judge to be assessed for type and conformation. When instructed, walk your horse straight away from the judge, a short distance as instructed by the steward, turn your horse around to the right, and trot back towards the judge and continue to trot.

The judge will move out of the way, continue to trot straight away from the judge and around the arena on the right rein, and down the long side of the arena, until you reach the end of the line up of horses.

Walk back to your place in the line. This allows the judge to see your horse's movement from the front and the rear in walk and trot, and again from the side.

Once all the horses have been assessed by the judge, he/she may walk down the line for a further comparison.

When instructed by the steward the first placed horse will be asked to lead off in walk around the arena on the right rein, the rest to follow on.

The Judge will make his/her final choice, instructing the steward the order in which to bring the horses in to line.

The Rosettes are awarded, the steward makes a note of the results and the class is completed.

(The final choice by the Judge is not completely done until the Rosett/Ribbon has been handed out.)

On instruction from the steward the horses will lead off at trot around the arena on a 'lap of honour' before leaving the ring.

Qualification: horses placed 1st and 2nd in each class of this show category are qualified for A and Title shows.

AMATEUR / NOVICE CLASSES - Combined classes - None Ecaho qualifier show.

Judging system – 7 criteria - 20 points with Half points, (20 points as maximum/ criteria.and total max 140points/judge) for the following criteria:

a)type, b) head & neck, c) body & topline, d) legs, e) movement, **f) harmony, g) presentation.**

HARMONY: / horsemanship shows the relation/communication between handler and horse.

PRESENTATION; Technical to show harmonious stand-up, straight walk and correct trot without interruption.

The points awarded by the judges will be added and divided with the number of judges for an average total.

If less than 3 in each class, the classes will be merged.

In the event of a tie in the qualifying of a class, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for

HARMONY. If there is still a tie, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for **TYPE**.

Failing a decision on either of these, one judge chosen by ballot will name his/hers preference

Conditions of Entry: Open to horses registered in any WAHO recognised stud book by the closing date of entries.

Entry Restrictions:

a) Title Show, A Show, B Show or C International Show Gold, Silver and Bronze winners are not allowed to take part in an Amateur Show for the rest of that calendar year and two calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior, from junior to a senior category.

Geldings that have won Champion Gold or Silver medals at a Title Show or an A show cannot be shown at Amateur shows/classes for the rest of that calendar year and one calendar year following.

b) The Handler of the horse must not have been paid for showing, training or producing any horse for a third party. This includes any remuneration either as employment, casual showing, or any in-kind benefits whatsoever.

Over qualified handlers taking part in a class will be disqualified and liable to pay a fine of €300.-

Horses placed 1st - 6th will receive a ribbon. The first, second and third in each class will receive a trophy to keep.

Amateur/Novice Championship: Standard Echa rules apply.

All qualified horses (1st and 2^{de} place in its class) of a category - Junior Males, Junior Females, Senior Males, Senior Females and Geldings (junior and senior or combined) - come into the ring.

The Judges chooses their Gold Champion Amateur/Novice from the First place horses, and then Silver and Bronze Champion Amateur/Novice from all other remaining horses.

Prizes, Ribbons and Garlands:

Horses placed 1st - 6th will receive a ribbon. The first, second and third in each class will receive a trophy to keep. Ribbons, trophies and a Garland will be awarded to Champion Gold Medal-winner and to Champion Silver Medal-winner and Champion Bronze Medal-winner.

A special trophy will be awarded to Best Novice in each class.

Amateur/Novice class: – Do not qualify for the A and Title shows and do NOT qualify for the open Championship.

FOAL CLASSES:

Judging system - Comparative System.

- a) Foals may not compete in EAHSC Championships, nor will they qualify for any future Title or A Show.
- b) EAHSC Rules will apply.
- c) Foals must have a minimum age of four weeks at the date of the show, and must be shown at foot (with the dam) up to 6 months of age. Orphaned or rejected foals under six month may not be shown.
- d) The use of metal halters and halters with metal chains is forbidden.

Foals - for identification purposes: Foals under six months shown in foal classes with their own mother need no special documentation, but the mother must have all necessary documents. Foals over 6 months shown without their dam, foals from Embryo Transplant or foals with foster mothers which are shown in foal classes and do not yet have a passport, must be micro-chipped and in possession of a copy of the official Stud Book Registration form, showing the micro-chip number and the graphic description of the foal.

Best Foal will be judges accordingly to judges preference in ranking order.

All Foals will receive Ribbons, and 1st and 2^{de} place will receive trophies to keep.

INTERNATIONAL B-SHOW:

Judging system - 5 criteria - 20 points with Half points (max 20 point/criteria) for the following criteria:

- a)type, b) head & neck, c) body & topline, d) legs, e) movement. Totally max 100 points.

The points awarded by the judges will be added and divided by the number of judges for an average total.

If less than 3 in each class, the classes will be merged.

In the event of a tie in the qualifying of a class, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for *TYPE*.

If there is still a tie, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for *MOVEMENTS*.

Failing a decision on either of these, one judge chosen by ballot will name his/hers preference.

Rules for ties in Qualifying classes:

In the event of a tie in the qualifying places of a class, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for type.

If there is still a tie, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for movement. Failing a decision on either of these, one judge chosen by ballot will name his preference.

Prizes, Ribbons and Garlands:

Horses placed 1st - 6th will receive a ribbon. The first, second and third in each class will receive a trophy to keep. Ribbons, trophies and a floral garland will be awarded to Champion Gold Medal-winners. Ribbons, trophies and a garland will be awarded to Champion Silver Medal-winners and Champion Bronze Medal-winners.

Depending on the number of horses entered, the show committee reserves the right to change (split or combine classes) and/or cancel classes according to the rules of ECAHO .

Conditions of Entry:

Open to horses registered in any WAHO recognized studbook by the closing date of entries.

Entry restrictions:

Title Show or A Show Champion Gold and Silver medal winners are not allowed to take part in a B show for the rest of that calendar year and the two calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a junior to a senior category. Geldings that have won Champion Gold or Silver medals at a Title Show or an A show cannot be shown at B shows for the rest of that calendar year and one calendar year following.

Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of €600 and the horse will be disqualified.

***ANY of First or Second place horse can be judged as Gold Champion!
Not only the class winners!!***

Championship, in accordance with EAHSC NEW rules for championships:**New method (Open method)**

The Gold, Silver and Bronze medal winners will be selected from amongst all the horses which have qualified in their respective classes for each championship.

1. The Championships will be judged as follows:

- a. All the horses qualified for the championship will enter the ring in trot one at the time and then walk round the ring and then line up according to the order of their catalogue numbers – lowest number first.
- b. The horses will be judged individually, standing and trotting.
- c. Each judge will nominate his choice for gold silver and bronze medals together at the same time, from amongst all the horses qualified for the championship.

Points will be given to the nominated horses as follows:

- **A horse nominated by a judge for Gold Medal will receive 4 points.**
- **A horse nominated by a judge for Silver Medal will receive 2 points.**
- **A horse nominated by a judge for Bronze Medal will receive 1 point.**

Rules for ties in Championships:

In the event of a tie in the championships, the higher place will be given to the horse with the highest total points in the qualifying classes. If there is still a tie, the rules for ties in qualifying places will be applied.

Liberty class: - According to Green Book 2017 and will be held Indoors. Please let us know in advance what music you like to be played for your horse in the Liberty class – Theme dress of horse and handler is invited.

Not a qualifier to A and Title shows nor qualifier to the open Championship

Judges gives each horse a mark for Movements , Conformation and Harmony between Handler and Horse. Highest points is the winner provided the horse was caught within the timeframe of 2 minutes after music stopped.

Conduct:

To ensure good judgement, the horse should enter the ring held by its handler, at an extended walk. The handler stops the horse in a natural position in front of the judges. The horse walks the straight line away and towards the judges, must be about 10 metres. Afterwards, the handler takes off the bridle completely and lets the horse run free in walk, trot and gallop/canter for a **maximum of 1,5 minutes**.

The horse will then have to be caught and a halter put on **within 2 minutes**. Any excess time results in elimination. If the horse does not adequately demonstrate all gaits, this should be reflected in the scores for movements. Music is recommended, any exhibitor may bring his own music in accordance with the organizer.

Any ties in Liberty will be resolved as follows: The better place will be given to the horse with the higher marks on MOVEMENT, followed by TYPE, and relationship with man.

Liability disclaimer:

The organiser shall not be liable for death, disease or damage to any person, horse or property however caused. It is furthermore an express condition of entry that each entrant shall indemnify the organisers against all actions, costs, claims, demands or liability what-so-ever arising out of any action in which he or she may be concerned. By signing the booking form you acknowledge and agree to all conditions and regulations set out in the show schedule.

Closing date of entries and payment is by JUNE 25th, 2017.

NOTE - Stabling fee is NOT refundable - Entry fee is only refundable if followed by veterinarian certificate!

A copy of the vaccination certificate, and photocopies of the registration-document have to be sent to the show-organiser together with the entry-form.

(There will be a strict control for the PASSPORT and veterinary-certificate!!)

- Please state name, age, sex, pedigree, owner of the horse and the name of the **handler** and your email address.
- It is important that a copy of the registration certificate is received in order to print the catalogue as correctly as possible.
- No horse will be permitted to enter the show-ring unless its name and relevant details have been printed in the catalogue.
- Should you enter any mare with foal is it important that you mention the age of the foal and the Sires name.
- Conflict of interest: Exhibitors will declare on the entry form any actual or apparent conflict of interest with any of the judges invited for the show. Any exhibitor **not** declaring an existing conflict of interest will forfeit all entry fees and will be prevented from showing the horse. Please study the ECAHO Blue Book 2017.

Documents:

- All horses must be free from infections and must come from a home-stock free from epidemic diseases - They must be vaccinated against **EQUINE INFLUENZA** (see below).
- Horses will also be checked for Ring-worm. Horses with Ring-worm will be **excluded** from the show-grounds!
- The Passport is to be presented and left with the show office in exchange for your entry number.
- Your Horse Passport will be handed back to you when returning your entry-number before your departure. Missing or destroyed number will be fined with 100 SEK in cash/each..

Vaccination rule (according to ECAHO's rules):

- The requirement for equine influenza vaccination: All horses must have received a primary course of two vaccination doses administered a minimum of 21 and a maximum of 92 days apart. Thereafter a third dose, first (1st) booster vaccination, must be given no more than 7 months after the second vaccination of the primary course.
- Booster vaccinations must be given at 12-month-interval i.e. within 365 days of the last dose.
- No vaccination may be given within 7 days of arrival at ECAHO event.
- Horses born before 2009 that have received the primary course of vaccinations but not the first 7 month booster will be allowed to participate without being sanctioned.
- For more information and to prevent misunderstanding, please study the EAHSC Rules in the Blue Book 2017:

Horses from abroad:

Horses from abroad arriving at the showground must be accompanied by E.C. health documents. Ask the veterinary service in your country. Horses from abroad can arrive from Wednesday the 19th of July.- Please inform us by email info@scandinavianopen.se when arrival is expected.

Stable:

Permanent wooden Boxes are available between Thursday July 20th – Monday July 24th.
(let us know when you plan to come)

Hay and Straw is free of charge – you have to help yourself to make up the box for your horse when you arrive.

The Boxes are in Permanent stables -

Please bring your own feed manger and water bucket.

Electricity, Water and Light is available as well as a Washing area for the horses.
